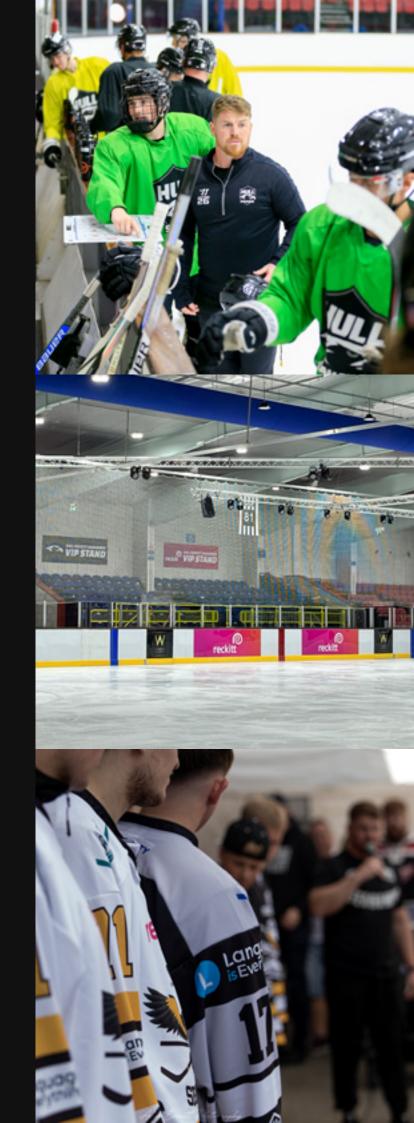
I think we are really making strides to try and improve the match night experience and make a game at the Hull Seahawks a real treat.
